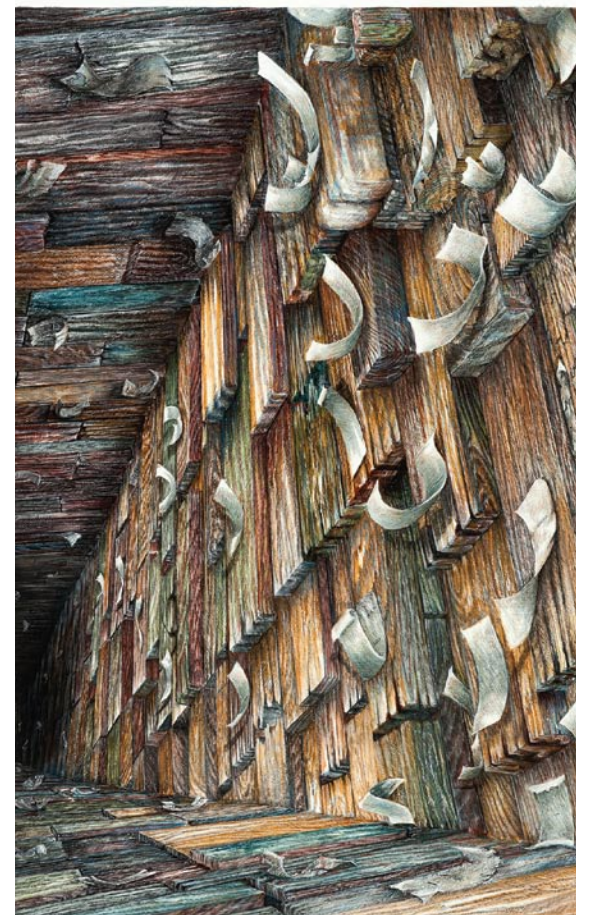

Through Mar 3, 2018**

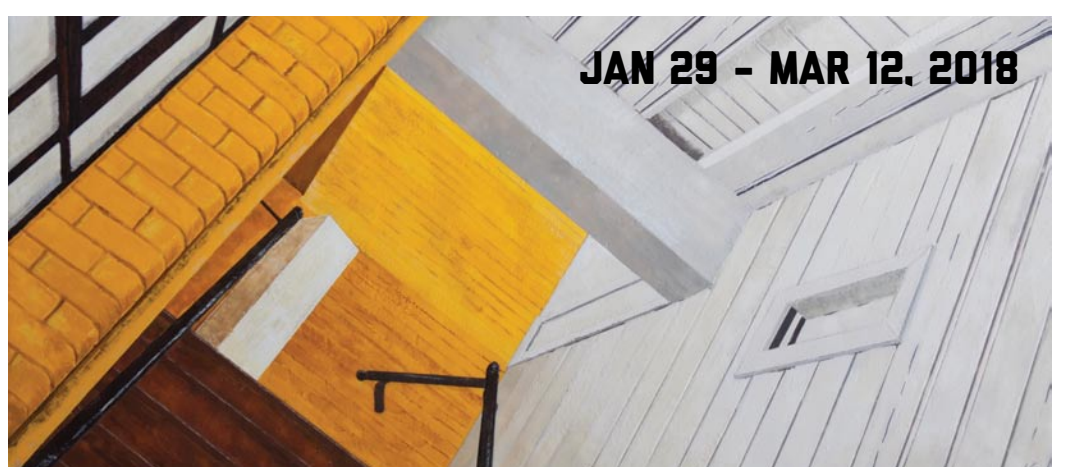
